ENDOCRINOLOGY NOTES PITUITARY DISORDERS Growth Hormone usually decreases following an elevation in blood glucose after a meal It is usually increased during sleep or during starvation It causes both retention of sodium and potassium which are required for growth metabolism Elevated GH levels increase IGF-1 blood levels Because IGF-1 levels

- DIABETES MELLITUS - Caused by decreased secretion of insulin - Can be insulin dependent (juvenile) or noninsulin dependent - Symp- polyuria, polyphagia, polydipsia, weight loss, blurred vision, and possible diabetic coma - If not treated, excess glucose in blood (hyperglycemia)

ENDOCRINOLOGY: study of endocrine glands and their secretions HORMONE: the bioactive "messenger" molecule secreted by an endocrine gland into the blood, ie not simply a metabolite or energy substrate ENDOCRINE: relates to hormone's action on target cells at a distance from source
